Membership numbers have dropped to below 50,000. Everyone is looking at ways to reduce costs and increase membership. If you have any ideas, please talk with me so I can pass them on to FMCA.

Elaine and I will be going to the International Convention in Indianapolis August 27th through August 30th. If you are planning to attend we would recommend you register at [FMCA Register](#) or call 800.543.3622 ASAP if you want 50 amp full hookup sites. 50 amp sites are currently available only for coaches 30 feet and under. 30 amp electric is available for all. Cancellation policies this year are a little different. Cancellations for attendance must be in writing and received by August 17th and FMCA will keep a \$10.00 cancellation fee. Cancellation of an electrical site after July 9th and before August 17th will include an additional cancellation fee of half the electric cost.

Elaine and I will be leaving for Indianapolis around August 21st or 22nd and going into the convention parking on August 25th. If you would like to travel with us, please let me know at 585.289.4792 or bartonta@gmail.com. Unless there is a groundswell of requests from the membership, the New York Centrals will not be volunteering at this year's FMCA convention.

RECIPES



SHRIMP APPETIZER SPREAD

Burr and Betsy Stoker

1 package (8 ounce) Cream Cheese, softened
½ cup Sour Cream
¼ cup Mayonnaise
3 packages (5 ounces each) frozen cooked Salad Shrimp- thawed
1 cup Heluva Good Seafood Sauce
2 cups (8 ounces) shredded Mozzarella Cheese (I use the finely shredded kind)
1 medium green Pepper- chopped
1 small Tomato – chopped (I remove the seeds to eliminate some of the juice)
3 green Onions with tops – sliced
Assorted crackers for dipping or can use the scoop chips

In a mixing bowl, beat the cream cheese until smooth. Add sour cream and mayonnaise and mix well. Spread mixture on a round twelve (12) inch serving platter. Sprinkle with the shrimp. Top with seafood sauce. Sprinkle the mozzarella cheese, chopped green peppers, tomatoes and green onions on top. Cover and refrigerate until ready to serve. You can use canned shrimp and eliminate the seeds from the tomatoes to keep it from being too juicy.
