HAVE YOU ICED YOUR CELL PHONE YET?

In many cases, if you are involved in an accident and are not able to tell the authorities or medical professionals whom to contact they will take it upon themselves to look through your belongings. They are trained to look for your cell phone for contact information. How will they know whom you want to notify? That is where the ICE contact comes in.

Before each contact that you want notified in case of emergency you list these three letters ICE. ICE stands for In Case of Emergency. ICE helps the authorities identify who they should contact in case of emergency.

Depending upon the limitations on your phone you may also consider listing important personal information in this spot. This may consist of your health condition, allergies, or even if you are an organ donor
